- Communicated a commitment to engage successfully in an accelerated, demanding and rigorous academic program

Based on the FAST schedule above, an additional 1-credit hour elective is needed to meet the University 120 credit hour degree requirement for graduation.

This BSW FAST format allows students to complete their Bachelor of Social Work program requirements more quickly than in traditional BSW programs.

Students who do not meet the FAST eligibility requirements or who wish a traditional academic experience are invited to apply to Detroit Mercy's BSW program and take the scheduling option at the standard semester pace. Core IT5 and IT6 (3 cr) must be taken at Detroit Mercy in traditional format.
